REPRESENTATIVE SQUAD CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct applies to all Wellington Representative and potential Representative players. It sets out your responsibilities to act in the best interest of the game when representing the district, and to maintain proper standards of integrity, conduct and performance. This document is to be read in conjunction with the Golf Wellington Code of Conduct

Principles of Behaviour

Players should fulfil their obligations to Golf Wellington Incorporated with professionalism and integrity.

- Players are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner.
- Maintain the appropriate standard of dress and show reasonable care for the uniform and gear supplied by Golf Wellington.
- Players should respect the rights of the officials and of other players.
- Refrain from conduct that may compromise your integrity, or bring Golf Wellington into disrepute through your activities on or off the course.
- Respect and follow instruction from Golf Wellington Officials and Management.
- Treat playing partners and people with whom you have official contact, with courtesy and respect.
- Players should avoid any activity (on or off the course), such as offensive language or abuse of equipment or the golf course, which could reflect badly on themselves or Golf Wellington or jeopardise its relationships with Clubs, Officials, Sponsors or the general public.
- All players who are representing Wellington or potential representative players, are subject to drug testing for banned substances as laid down in Golf New Zealand's Anti-Doping Policy. Any player infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be removed from a team
- All players who are representing Wellington or potential representative players, are subject to the Golf Wellington policy on alcohol, and guidelines set by team management on the use of social media while a representative match is in progress

Breaches of the Representative Code of Conduct

Any behaviour or action that leads to a complaint against you, which may be in breach of this Code, will be sent to the Golf Wellington Disciplinary Committee. They shall preside over and pass judgement on disciplinary matters or breaches of the Golf Wellington Representative Code of Conduct Policy.
